



Garden Shed Design and Build Competition

Information and Rules

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Overview:

CAOB is sponsoring a friendly competition amongst high school and college students to plan, design and build a Garden Shed.

The Unveiling will take place on January 21, 2017. The Garden Sheds will be delivered on the morning of the 21st and on display in a secure location for a week. Bidding will commence at the opening reception (Attendance by teams, supervisors and sponsors is complementary, otherwise by ticket purchase or special invitation only.) Bidding can continue during the week. Announcing the winning bids, the winning sheds and prize awards presentations will be on January 27, 2017.

Teams

Teams may number up to a maximum of four students to construct the Sheds and one adult supervisor. Additional students may participate in the budgeting, planning, design and writing the assembly directions.

Teams must register with CAOB before October 15, 2016. Each team will receive \$500 to apply to the purchase of building materials.

Team members and supervisors may be asked to participate in media interviews.

Building Specifications

Teams are encouraged to be creative when designing but also practical when choosing a design and building materials.

1. The footprint of the shed cannot exceed 100 square feet.
2. The Garden Shed must be Bermuda weather-resistant.
3. The Garden Shed must have a minimum of one standard size door
4. The Garden Shed must have at least one window.
5. Must be able to dismantle and assemble according to instructions.
6. Must have a floor
7. May be decorated



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Special Awards:

1. Best use of recycled or recyclable materials
2. Best provision for storage
3. Best Business plan: including budget, design specifications, and assembly instructions.
4. Most creative design
5. Most Bermuda-centric design

Prizes:

1. The educational facility **department** of the Winning Teams will receive:
 - a. 1st place: \$3,000 to spend on upgrading curricula, materials or tools for technical or trades teaching purposes.
 - b. 2nd place: \$2,000 to spend on upgrading curricula or materials for technical or trades teaching purposes.
 - c. 3rd place: \$1,000 to spend on upgrading curricula or materials for technical or trades teaching purposes.
2. Best overall Garden Shed. – Trophy
3. Participation Plaques for each team.

Participation Incentives

1. Each participating team will receive \$500 to use towards building materials. Teams may raise additional money if required. Money spent must correspond with the budgets.
2. Each student will receive a Certificate of participation and a CAOB gift set.

Any additional proceeds from this event go towards the CAOB Scholarship Fund. Scholarships are awarded to students seeking training and education in construction related careers.

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
